A few park rules & expectations are listed below to ensure the safety, protection & enjoyment of everyone in the park.

RESPONSIBILITY The person whose name appears on the receipt is responsible for the conduct of all members of his/her party. Offensive behaviour will not be tolerated.

SPEED For the safety of everyone is 8km per hour .

QUIET TIME Outside noise to be kept to a minimum between 10pm and 8am in consideration of others in the park.

SITES/ACCOMMODATION are to be kept clean & tidy at all times.

ADDITIONAL GUESTS AND VISITORS must use the visitor's carpark. Please do not park in roadways or other sites. Additional overnight guests must register with the office & pay an overnight fee.

OPEN FIRES are not allowed. Permission for all contained fires must be given by management, who can advise on the current season.

PETS While we are a dog friendly park, there are a few rules that need to be followed to allow us to remain this way. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and are not to be left unsupervised within the park. Please clean up after your dogs. Dogs aren't allowed in any park buildings (excluding selected dog-friendly cabins) or inside pool/bbq areas. No washing or drying of dogs or dog items in basins, washing machines or dryers. Please bring your dogs bedding as they are not allowed on park furniture.

BICYCLES/SCOOTERS Please wear helmets and no riding in or around amenities/bbq area, or through the park after dark. Please also observe the 8km per hour speed limit.

SWIMMING POOL is open between 8am and 8pm. Pool rules must be observed at all times. Umbrellas are only to be operated by staff to avoid injury. Pool towels are available from the office for guests staying in accommodation.

DISC GOLF An 18 hole course is open to the public behind the Holiday Park. Discs are available to hire from the office.

SMOKING is not permitted within any park buildings or within 10 metres of the pool, BBQ, Camp Kitchen or playground areas. All accommodation is non-smoking.
A \$200 fine applies and will be charged to credit card on file.

Only 1 Car Per Site Please

Check in time is 2pm for accommodation and 12 noon for sites.

Check out time is 10am – a later check in may be arranged by request.

Office/kiosk is open from 9am to 5pm Sunday to Thursday and 9am to 6pm Friday/Saturday and during school holidays.

FIRST AID KIT is located in the office. **AED** is located in the laundry.

WILDLIFE No feeding of animals or birds - they need to survive without you.

BBQs are provided for everyone's use and cleaned daily. Please ensure the BBQ and gas are turned off after use (if applicable) and left in a clean and tidy manner.

LAUNDRY is open between 8am and 9pm. All machines use either \$1 coins (the office can provide change) or accept EFTPOS. Washing powder is available for purchase. Please remove washing promptly once washed, dried in consideration of others wanting to use the machines / clothesline.

CAMP KITCHEN is open between 8am and 10pm. A coin operated coffee machine is located in the Camp Kitchen. Please clean up after yourself, wash, dry and put away your dishes and turn the light and air-conditioner/heater off if you're last to leave.

ARCADE ROOM is open between 8am and 9pm.

RUBBISH Please place all rubbish and recycling in the appropriate bins situated around the park. All 10c cans and bottles can be placed in the small wheelie bins, with profits going to labelled charities.

DUMP POINT Please only dispose of human waste and (minimal) toilet paper. No flushable wipes, nappies, sanitary products or food waste. Please advise Management immediately if you notice a blockage. Hose any spills after use to keep area sanitary for next guest.

ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING is prohibited on site powerheads. Please see staff for nearest EV station.

EMERGENCY EVACUATION meeting point is in front of the unpowered camping carpark on the grass. If an emergency, such as a bushfire evolves, please meet at this location and follow all instructions given by management.

REFUNDS are unable to be given for early departure or delayed arrival.

CHILDREN under 12 must be supervised at all times.
